**ZOOTOO.COM FOUNDER NARROWS DOWN TOP 20
 SHELTER MAKEOVER CONTEST FINALISTS TO TOP THREE
 LIVE ON STAGE AT 2008 HSUS ANIMAL CARE EXPO ON MAY 15th**

*20 Finalist Shelters Each Receive Checks On-Site--
 Winning Shelter Will Be Announced on May 21st*

SECAUCUS, NJ (May 2008) – Richard Thompson, founder of **Zootoo.com**—the pet lover’s website—will take the stage at the 2008 HSUS Animal Care EXPO Conference with representatives from the Top 20 Shelters of the **Zootoo.com Shelter Makeover Contest** to reveal the three lucky shelters who will continue on to become eligible for a makeover valued at up to one million dollars*. The presentation will also feature video highlights from the 20-city tour of all the Finalist Shelters; 20 will receive checks on-site, and the Three Finalists will be flown to New York City, where the grand prize winning shelter will be announced *live* on The Morning Show with Mike and Juliet on May 21st.
